This role has responsibility for the coordination of EHCP's including attending EHCP reviews for potential new learners onto the programme and conducting reviews for existing learners. This role will ensure that all EHCP's are up to date with relevant outcomes that relate directly to the aspirations of learners.

This role involves working collaboratively with a range of stakeholders such as local authorities, parents/carers and learners. The primary function of this role is to coordinate the EHCP review process in a timely manner in order to ensure reviews are conducted in line with SEND Code of Practice. The role will ensure that suitable learners are recruited onto the programmes and informed decisions are made based on observations, written documents, family contribution and most importantly the learner voice.

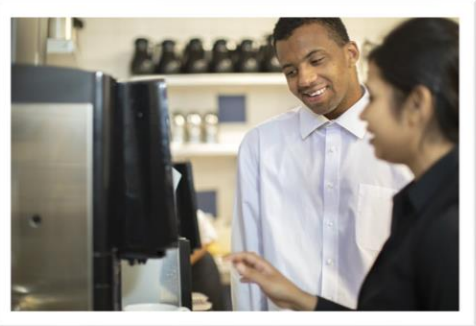

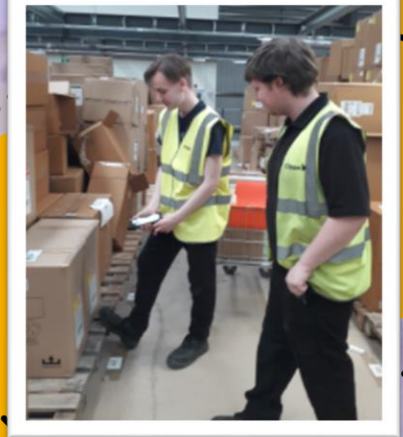
