It is important to us that

- It is important that staff have read our support plan and risk assessments in order to know how we like to be supported as we have complex needs
- As some of us are non-verbal it is important that staff know how we communicate and be our advocates when needed especially when out in the community
- It is important that staff are aware of our personal care needs and that some tenants may require more personal care than others
- Some of us need support with our mobility as we are all wheelchair users however some are more able bodied and require assistance with walking while others require full support
- It is important when supporting with our meals that staff are aware of our individual SALT assessments
- It is important that we are supported to any off our appointments including health appointments, eye appointments or dental appointments

We are great at

- Being inclusive

We sometimes find it difficult to

- Always communicating our needs
- Sourcing transport as we are located outside of the main town

We need support to

- Take medication including daily medication however some of us suffer from epilepsy and may require the use of rescue medication Buccal Midazolam
- Attend appointments
- Support with finance
- Household chores
- Support with meals
- Grocery shopping
- Personal care

** It is important to note that Tullyrush is located 5 miles outside of Omagh and will require transport to get in and out of the town. It is preferred that staff are able to drive for this reason**
