About the Team and the Role

Me Time Team aims to promote equality of opportunity and increased social inclusion, seeking community connections and local partners

The Community Inclusion Facilitator's focus is on:

- Building community connections, circles of support for greater independence and confidence, by creating partnerships in the local community
- Ensure the plans put in place for the people we support are person centred, and the person is fully involved in all aspect of the planning and review process.
- Be responsible for ensuring that each person can build on their strengths and develop their skills to be able to increase independence and make choices.
- Measuring outcomes and impact experienced by the people being supported and providing case studies and stories to evidence impact.
- Focused on improving quality of life for the people supported as well as providing pathways to other opportunities, for example volunteering and employment.
- Build a rapport with the people we support, their family members, carers, other professionals and community partners

What you will bring to the role (Essentials)

The Community Inclusion Facilitator will:

- Demonstrate positive relationships with others, e.g. people with learning disabilities, families, carers, colleagues.
- Ability to offer personal care support with compassion, dignity & respect.
- Will be responsible for ensuring the safety and wellbeing of people being supported.
- A reflective and honest approach to own performance and take accountability for the planning and achievement of personal objectives.
- Ability to become spontaneous with dialogue and creativity in 1:1 and group activity sessions, adapt and respond to the needs of individuals.
- Competent at completing all recording requirements in a timely manner
- Be flexible and can work from different locations and projects within the community.
- Be a role model for Mencap's five values in all your work activities
