<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• It is important that staff have read our support plan and risk assessments in order to know how we like to be supported as we have complex needs</li> <li>• As some of us are non-verbal it is important that staff know how we communicate and be our advocates when needed especially when out in the community</li> <li>• It is important that staff are aware of our personal care needs and that some tenants may require more personal care than others</li> <li>• Some of us need support with our mobility as we are all wheelchair users however some are more able bodied and require assistance with walking while others require full support</li> <li>• It is important when supporting with our meals that staff are aware of our individual SALT assessments</li> <li>• It is important that we are supported to any off our appointments including health appointments, eye appointments or dental appointments</li> </ul>

<u>We are great at</u>

<u>We sometimes find it difficult to</u>

<u>We need support to</u>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Take medication - including daily medication however some of us suffer from epilepsy and may require the use of rescue medication Buccal Midazolam</li> <li>• Attend appointments</li> <li>• Support with finance</li> <li>• Household chores</li> <li>• Support with meals</li> <li>• Grocery shopping</li> <li>• Personal care</li> </ul>

**\*\* It is important to note that Tullyrush is located 5 miles outside of Omagh and will require transport to get in and out of the town. It is preferred that staff are able to drive for this reason\*\***
