- focus on building community connections, circles of support for greater independence and confidence, by creating partnerships in the local community

- ensure the plans put in place for the people we support are person centred, and the person is fully involved in all aspect of the planning and review process.
- be responsible for ensuring that each person can build on their strengths and develop their skills to be able to increase independence and make choices.
- Measuring outcomes and impact experienced by the people being supported and providing case studies and stories to evidence impact.
- raise any concerns using the appropriate channels, particularly in relation to safeguarding.

- Evidence of positive relationship with others e.g., people we support, families, carers and colleagues.
- Complete all recording requirements in a timely manner
- A reflective and honest approach to own performance and take accountability for the planning and achievement of personal objectives.
- Be a role model Mencap's five values in all your work activities
