We support a number of individuals who have learning disabilities across a several locations in the West Bridgeford area of Nottingham.

We need the people who work at our services to be calm, flexible, positive and having a good sense of humour really helps too.

The people we support all have different interests, skills and aspirations and we want to employ people who can adapt their approach so as to support people in a person centred way.

People enjoy a range of interests and hobbies and if you share them this can be a great way of getting to know people. People enjoy shopping, going to the theatre, drama, football and visiting places of interest. The people we support want to be supported by people who are trustworthy, caring, and inclusive.

We need you to be able to:

- Work as part of a team which provides 24 hours support, so it is essential that the people who work are able to work a range of shifts; evenings, weekends and sleep in duties.
- Support individuals with personal care tasks, domestic tasks again training will be provided to you if you do not have experience of supporting others in this way.
- To work as part of a team, but to also be able to work on your own initiative.
- Experience is desirable, but not essential as we will provide you with all of the training you will need to do the job. The training includes digital and taught courses, shadowing others in the workplace and mentoring by existing members of staff.
