Could you work here

We support four people with moderate learning disabilities in their own homes with all aspects of daily living. One person is a wheelchair user. We support people with personal care, with their medication, and to attend health appointments. Support also includes budgeting, shopping, cooking and other domestic duties.

We also support people to access their community for leisure and recreation, and to maintain relationships with people who are important to them. Some hobbies and interests include – going to the theatre, cinema, shopping, playing bingo, and going to the disco.

Our staff team need to be organised and flexible and be prepared to engage in a number of activities so shifts can be busy. You need to be able to work as part of a team, lone work where necessary, be confident and adaptable, and be able to work in a person centred way.

If you can work in a people orientated role, are a caring person who enjoys enabling people to achieve their life goals and aspirations we would love to hear from you. Experience within the care sector is an advantage but not a necessity as full training will be provided. You will be required to work on a rota basis which will include mornings, evenings and weekends.
